Three two-day modules for community food and community health organisations that want to establish a social enterprise or new income generating idea.

Starting Your Social Enterprise (SYSE) is an essential programme for community food and community health initiatives that want to set up a thriving and sustainable social enterprise or new income stream.

The programme is ideal for community food and community health organisations that are at the stage of exploring the feasibility of their business ideas and preparing a business plan OR exploring new ways of generating income for their organisations. You will be given business start-up knowledge and tools and skills to help you create, develop and sustain your social enterprise or new income stream.

The programme includes three two-day modules, delivered over eight weeks. The programme is fully funded by CFHS.

Places are available for the whole programme OR individual modules.

Module One – Understanding Social Enterprise

On: 21 September and 27 September
At: Consumer Focus Scotland, Glasgow

Understanding Social Enterprise (USE) will introduce you to the concept of social enterprise, the challenges established enterprises currently face and what the future holds for this emerging business model. USE is ideal for organisations interested in learning about social enterprise and its potential within the community food and community health fields.

The module's content includes: an introduction to social enterprise; business models; legal structures; governance; strategic vision; mission and objectives; and input from a social enterprise.

Module Two – Marketing Your Social Enterprise (day one) & Introduction to Finance (day two)

On: 19 October and 26 October

At: Consumer Focus Scotland, Glasgow

From: 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Marketing Your Social Enterprise (MYSE) will provide you with an ideal setting to test your social enterprise business ideas, or your ideas for new products and services that will generate income for your organisation. In this highly participative session you will be able to assess your ideas and their sustainability. MYSE is suitable for organisations interested in developing a new social enterprise, whether this is a start up social enterprise, a new trading arm for your organisation or a new product or service.

The content of the day includes: market research; product and service ideas; your Unique Selling Point; pricing; and promotions.

Introduction to Finance is an ideal starting point for your financial learning. In a competitive environment it is imperative that you understand the dynamics of finance and have the awareness to spot new opportunities for income streams. This session is useful if you are interested in exploring and understanding the trading potential for your organisation, or new to financial management.

The day will include: an introduction to financial concepts; improving financial performance; income sources.

Module Three - Leadership and Strategic Planning

On: 8 November and 17 November
At: Consumer Focus Scotland, Glasgow

From: 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

This module explores the importance of leadership within organisations whilst considering the responsibilities of strategic business planning within your social enterprise. This highly engaging module will allow you to share and reflect upon your experiences amongst peers, and develop practical skills to take back to your organisation. The module is suitable for individuals who are, or expect to be, in a position of responsibility in the near future, and who are keen to explore the importance of successful leadership for their social enterprises.

The module's content includes: business planning; peer support; leadership skills; review, reflection and evaluation; next steps.
